

BSC YL – Covid Contingency Plan 2022

Policy Statement

The spread of Coronavirus has been rapid and unpredictable. This policy has been drawn up to raise awareness of the steps that BSC YL Central and BSC YL Centres take to mitigate the spread of the virus throughout our workplace and the locations where we undertake our lessons, activities and pastoral care. The remit of this policy is to:

- Make everyone aware of the precautions BSC Young Learners (BSC YL) take at our centres
- Define procedures to be followed should staff or students display symptoms or receive positive Covid19 test results
- Define measures the company is taking to prevent Coronavirus from being transmitted via lessons, activities and pastoral care
- Describe how the plan will be managed and monitored during a Coronavirus outbreak
- Detailed contingency plans on the Quarantine Covid Centre implemented at BSC YL Wycliffe 2022.

COVID 19 TESTING

BSC YL will provide two types of Covid19 testing at every centre:

Government approved PCR Test – (At a cost to the student/staff member.) To be taken every time symptoms are displayed by the person.

<u>'NHS' Lateral Flow Test</u> – Provided free of charge by BSC YL. These are regular rapid lateral flow tests, even without the displaying of coronavirus symptoms.



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ENGLISH CLASSES - WHAT TO DO?

What will BSC YL do?	What students need to do?
 Students will maintain a distance of 2 metres in classrooms Give students their own personal chair & desk/table space Give students extra learning materials in digital format via the class online learning portal, instead of on paper. Students still receive their own paper copy of the course book Keep windows (and doors, where possible) open to allow for ventilation Teachers will always wear face masks. 	 Be careful to enter and exit the class, making sure to keep a distance of 2 metres from everyone else Wear a face mask at all times Keep to own personal chair and desk Report to the teacher immediately if feeling unwell.

CENTRE TEAM OFFICE - WHAT TO DO?

What will BSC YL do?	What students need to do?
 Create 2 metre distances of desks/tables Allowing one student at a time in each office, with a socially distanced queuing system outside Clear signs, emergency numbers and Covid19 safety precaution posters readily available outside Centre Management will give thorough Covid19 safety advice during inductions. Keep windows (and doors, where possible) open to allow for ventilation 	 Never go into the office if there is another student in there Make sure you queue safely outside, maintaining at least 2 metres between you and everyone else Avoid touching the doors, noticeboards and door handles If students are feeling unwell whilst within close proximity to the office then students should report to a Manager in the office immediately.



IN THE ACCOMMODATION – WHAT TO DO?

What will BSC YL do?	What students need to do?
 Clean and disinfect the house daily in close collaboration with the Host Centre cleaning teams Maintain a regular schedule of cleaning and disinfecting Daily inspections carried out by welfare teams and to be managed by the Welfare Manager Provide hand sanitiser in all common rooms Laundry rota to be implemented Never allow visitors into the house No students from other 'house' bubbles to enter a different 'house' bubble residence Wear face masks at all times Host regular evening meetings to monitor student welfare. Take regular 'Lateral Flow' testing for staff and students 	 Maintain social distancing from other students in the house. Wash hands thoroughly upon entering Do not gather in the kitchen unless maintaining social distancing Use anyone else's belongings Wear face masks when there are COVID19 cases (as instructed by the Welfare Team) Avoid touching common objects like table tops, doors handles and stair cases Arrive/exit through designated areas It's advised for students to complete the welfare journey questionnaires to provide additional feedback on their welfare Students should tell their Welfare Leader if they are feeling unwell anytime they are in the residence. Attend testing during House evening meetings

DURING ACTIVITIES - WHAT TO DO?

What will BSC YL do?	What students need to do?
 Clean and disinfect the equipment daily Maintain a regular schedule of cleaning and disinfecting Provide hand sanitiser to all participants Never allow visitors to participate in any activity Wear face masks at all times Temperature check on arrival Thorough Covid19 Health Safety during excursion briefings Covid19 Risk Assessments for all excursions and activities Comply to all suppliers/attractions Covid19 Risk Assessments Avoid physical contact with students and staff. 	 Wash hands thoroughly upon arrival Do not use anyone else's belongings Arrive/exit through designated areas Maintain 2 metres distancing while not physically engaged in activity Avoid celebrating goals/scores/wins with high 'fives' or hugs Report to the Activity Manager immediately if they are feeling unwell.

They are monitored by their House-WL/AL (wearing PPE) Students continue English lessons via hybrid classrooms Outside 'house bubble' afternoon excursions/activities are cancelled and some online events created Evening house activities from the same house cancelled Other afternoon/evening activities in other house (bubbles) can continue with staff and students wearing face masks The Centre is thoroughly cleaned and disinfected BSC YL Central informed for guidance and the possibility of providing additional support/staffing Centre Management liaise with the Host Centre Liaison Officer about COVID19 procedures Parents and agent/s are informed.
<u>d)</u>	A number of students from at least 2 classes and different houses have tested positive	 All concerning houses and students (including all the resident ALs and WLs) have to self-isolate for 10 days The houses are supervised and monitored hourly with meals delivered by the WM/ActM and CM (wearing PPE) Additional support staff sent from head office to support the centre Students from the 2 classes continue English lessons via hybrid classrooms All House evening activities in the affected house 'bubbles' are cancelled All Outside afternoon excursions/activities are cancelled and some online events created The Centre is thoroughly cleaned and disinfected Parents and agent/s are informed BSC YL Central informed for guidance and the possibility of providing additional support/staffing Centre Management liaise with the Host Centre Liaison Officer about COVID19 procedures.
<u>e)</u>	An Activity Leader or a Welfare Leader display symptoms	 The AL or WL is tested (PCR) and self isolates until the test is returned, monitored by the WM (given meals, wearing PPE) The ActM or WM covers the duties until the test result comes back To introduce staggered start/end times to activity sessions Everyone from the same accommodation block has to wear face masks inside the house until the result is confirmed

<u>a)</u>	A Teacher displays symptoms	 The Ts has to isolate, take a PCR test and is monitored by the WM (and given meals wearing PPE) Every student from the same class has to wear a face mask into the accommodation until Ts test has returned To introduce staggered start/end times to lessons Everyone who stays in the same accommodation block has to wear face masks in the house until the test is returned The AAM/or AM teaches the class until the result returns The centre is thoroughly cleaned and disinfected Evening House activities continue with everyone wearing face masks Outside afternoon excursions/activities continue with everyone wearing face masks BSC YL Central informed for guidance and the possibility of providing additional support/staffing.
<u>h)</u>	A Teacher tests positive	 The Ts has to isolate and is monitored by the WM (and given meals wearing PPE) Everyone in the same house block has to isolate for ten days and take lateral flow tests All students from the same class have to isolate for ten days and they are monitored/delivered meals by WL/ALs The students receive English hybrid classes The AAM/or AM teaches hybrid class until isolation is over The centre is thoroughly cleaned and disinfected House evening (the respective teachers house) activities cancelled Other house bubble evening activities can continue with staff/students wearing face masks



<u>i)</u>	A Manager displays symptoms	 (Other house bubble) Outside afternoon excursions/activities can continue with everyone wearing face masks Parents/agent's informed BSC YL Central informed for guidance and the possibility of providing additional support/staffing Centre Management liaise with the Host Centre Liaison Officer about COVID19 procedures. The Manager is tested and isolates until the PCR test result is received The Manager is monitored by the Welfare Team (hourly check-ups and meals delivered) Everyone staying in the same house has to wear face masks in the accommodation until test result is returned All Members of Management are tested (lateral flow) and wear masks everywhere until the test is returned Management cover each other's duties (as instructed by the CM) All evening activities can continue with staff/students wearing face masks All outside excursions/activities can continue with everyone wearing face masks The centre is thoroughly cleaned and disinfected BSC YL Central informed for guidance and the possibility of providing additional support/staffing.
<u>i)</u>	A Manager tests positive	 BSC TE Central minimed for guidance and the possibility of providing additional support stanling. The Manager isolates for 10 days All other Managers isolate for 10 days depending on the test results An entire Management and Support team is sent by Head Office to manage the centre Everyone (including all staff/students) staying in the same house has to isolate for 10-day period Hybrid English lessons occur The House Bubble (the same house as the Manager) afternoon/evening activities are cancelled, some online events created Other 'house bubbles' afternoon excursions/activities and evening activities can continue with everyone wearing face masks Parents/agents are informed The centre is thoroughly cleaned and disinfected Centre Management liaise with the Host Centre Liaison Officer about COVID19 procedures Final Review to be made by Head Office to discuss closing the centre.

BSC YL WYCLIFFE QUARANTINE CENTRE

BSC Young Learners has introduced a Covid19 quarantine facility at the prep school of BSC YL Wycliffe College in Gloucestershire to cater for student groups that will need to quarantine upon arrival (in accordance to the latest UK governments travel guidance).

The Centre will have at least 1 Teacher and 1 Welfare Leader (who have both been doubled vaccinated) residing with them at the centre. (Possibly an additional Activity Leader is the numbers are above 1:15) The students will attend English lessons at the Main Centre (depending on Covid19 scenarios) during the afternoons whilst the Main Centre – students are experienced activities/or excursions

Below are the health and safety measures to be taken at the Quarantine Centre:

<u>b)</u>	An individual student tests positive for COVID19 in the Quarantine Centre	 The entire Quarantine Centre (including the resident WLs/ALs/Ts) has to isolate for 10 days on top of the remaining quarantine days The Quarantine Centre is supervised/monitored (hourly) with meals delivered by the WM (wearing PPE) Students continue English lessons via online hybrid classrooms Evening activities from the Quarantine House are cancelled and some online events created The Quarantine Centre is thoroughly cleaned and disinfected

<u>h)</u>	The Quarantine Group Teacher tests positive	 The Ts has to isolate and is monitored by the WM (and given meals wearing PPE) Everyone in Quarantine Centre (including AL/WL) has to isolate for 10 days on top of the remaining quarantine days. To be monitored/delivered meals by the Welfare Team The students receive English online hybrid classes The AAM/or AM teaches hybrid class until isolation is over Evening activities from the Quarantine House are cancelled and some online events created The Quarantine Centre is thoroughly cleaned and disinfected BSC YL Central informed for guidance and the possibility of providing additional support/staffing Centre Management liaise with the Host Centre Liaison Officer about COVID19 procedures
