HOW TO APPLY

- Apply and pay online at - <https://www.british-study.com/en/exams/>
 - You must apply BEFORE 16:00pm ON THE ENTRIES CLOSING DATE.
 - Write your name EXACTLY how you want it to appear on your certificate (e.g. John William Smith)
 - You must provide a copy of your VALID PHOTOGRAPHIC ID that you will have to bring on the exam day(s). This should be your passport or national identity card.
 - If you have any special requirements or requests (for the written or speaking exam), please write this clearly in the relevant section of the application form at the time of application. We cannot process requests after your application has been received. Please note: all special requirements for your exam must be processed before the entries closing date.

No refunds will be given to candidates who are not able to attend any of the parts of the exam. It is not possible to transfer to another centre or another exam session. If you cannot attend the exam due to illness or due to compassionate reasons, please contact us directly. In the event of a remark, if your grade changes, £50.00 administration fee still applies.

WHEN WILL I GET MY EXAM TIMETABLE

- You will get the email from Cambridge Assessment English (@cambridgeenglish.org) 2-3 weeks before the written exam date for paper-based exams and 1-2 weeks before the written exam date for computer-based exams containing 2 documents:
 - Confirmation of Entry (CoE): this includes your exam timetable (including the exact time of your speaking exam), venue details, important information for the test day, and your login details to view your result online.
 - Summary of Regulations: the exam day rules you must read before the exam

Check your JUNK MAIL folder - emails sometimes appear here due to privacy settings.

If you have not received the email one week before the written papers exam date, you MUST contact the exam centre immediately.

- You will be given an exact time of your speaking exam which will be on the Confirmation of Entry. Please arrive at the test centre 20 minutes before the start of your speaking test to register. For the speaking exam: afternoon sessions are held between 14:00 and 17:30. Evening sessions are held between 17:00 and 20:45.
- You MUST bring original valid proof of photographic ID on all exam days - this must be the same as used on application.
